### MLA Style Notes for Works Cited and Parenthetical (In-text) Citations

#### **Book** (one author)

Works Cited: Author Last name, First name. Title. Place of Publication: Publisher, Year Published. Print.

**Example:** Johnson, Charles Richard. *Middle Passage*. New York: Atheneum, 1990. Print.

**Parenthetical:** (Last name & page number). **Example:** (Johnson 147).

[The period is always on the **outside** or the parenthetical citation.]

# A Page on a Website

**Works Cited:** Author's Last name, First name. "Name of Page." *Website name*. Date of Posting/Revision. Name of Organization/Institution affiliated with the site (sometimes found in copyright statements). Web. Date you accessed the site. <URL>.

## **Example:**

Smith, Bob. "Periodic Table of Elements." Science Facts. 5 Sept. 2001. Los Alamos National Laboratory's

Chemistry Division. Web. 10 Sept. 2006. <a href="http://pearl11.1an1.gov/default.htm">http://pearl11.1an1.gov/default.htm</a>.

**Parenthetical:** (First information available). **Example:** (Smith). OR ("Periodic Table of Elements").

### Helpful Tips:

- Sources must be in alphabetical order based on the first provided information.
- Look for the © symbol to find the name of organization.
- Make sure to use hanging indents.
