Course Description:

Development of the ability to analyze, criticize, and advocate ideas: relationship of language to logic, facts, inferences, judgements, and formal and informal fallacies of language and thought. Instruction in writing about issues of critical thinking to develop both thinking and writing skills.

Course Objectives:

Students will have a broad understanding of active reading procedures, ability to summarize, paraphrase, and use proper MLA format, make inferences, annotate both expository text and literature while developing an argument in which they can persuade readers through their writing.

Assignment Policy:

Class assignments will be assigned each week. The heading on ALL assignments will be in proper MLA format. All assignments will only be accepted in **pencil or dark blue/black ink**. Late work or any work not meeting the standards set forth by the homework policy will receive ZERO CREDIT. All homework is due when it is collected. If absent, it is due upon your return and/or you will receive an extension that equals the amount of time in class you have missed.
